**Courses offered for 2021**

**\*Introduction to Māori language**

**\*Māori language – Full Day**

We work with EC educators, centres, services, and organisations (mainstream) to help strengthen people’s ability and confidence to speak te reo Māori. We aim to provide a safe, inspiring and fun learning environment. Teachers Council expects all teachers to be committed to te reo (Maori Language and Tikanga Maori) throughout their teaching career).

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**Course 1: Introduction - Te Reo Māori (Māori Language)** 2 hours 45 minutes

**Learning Outcomes:** Gain confidence and understanding in Māori Language

Participants will:

- Develop pronunciation skills
- Learn/practice te reo Māori words, directives, phrases waiata and games for an early childhood environment
- Discuss and develop strategies to encourage whole centre use of Te Reo Māori

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**Course 2: Te Reo Māori (Māori language)** Full day course (Saturday)

**Learning Outcomes:** Develop skills and understanding in the use of te reo Māori in everyday contexts

Participants will:

- Learn/practice a variety of te reo Māori words, phrases, waiata and games for an early childhood setting
- Explore apps that support children and teacher’s learning te reo Māori

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**Course 3: Infants and Toddlers - Te Reo Māori** 2 ½ hours

**Learning Outcomes:** Develop confidence and use of te reo Māori for infants and toddlers

Participants will:

- Practice/learn waiata and rhymes/poems
- Practice/learn te reo Māori words, directives, and phrases to use in infant and toddler classrooms including phrases to use during routine and transition time

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**Course 4: Educators in the Home** 2 hours

**Learning Outcomes:** Gain confidence and understanding in te reo Māori and tikanga practices

Participates will learn:

- Prayer (Karakia) for the start of the day and before meals
- Songs (Waiata) for greetings, counting, shapes
- Protocols and customs (Tikanga)
- Pronunciation and language practice; greetings, giving directives/instructions, positive phrases, phrases for caregiving routines
